Kohli Fellowship 2025

The Kohli Fellowship for Sociology promotes researchers who have finished their dissertation with excellent success. It offers researchers a two-year research stay at a prestigious research institution to engage in a new research project, to advance publications, and to develop research collaborations. The Kohli Fellowships are sponsored by the Kohli Foundation for Sociology.

In 2025, the Kohli Fellow is invited to conduct their research at the European University Institute (EUI) in Fiesole/Florence. The Kohli Fellowship is a postdoctoral fellowship within the Max Weber Programme for Postdoctoral Studies. The MWP is the world's largest postdoctoral programme in the social sciences and humanities, hosting 60-70 postdoctoral fellows annually in the fields of social and political sciences, economics, history and law. Max Weber Fellows are expected to work on their own research projects, and they are assigned a mentor from the EUI faculty.

The research stay begins on September 1, 2025, and the fellowship is awarded for 24 months. The current monthly stipend is € 2,500, subject to revision.

Interested candidates can apply within the framework of the <u>MWP's general</u> <u>call for applications</u>.

The application should include the following documents:

- A Curriculum Vitae, including a list of publications
- An 'Academic Career Statement'
- A Research Proposal
- The names of two to three academic referees and at least two letters of reference
