Sociology on Stage

The Kohli Foundation invites **theater and cultural professionals** to bring **sociological perspectives on stage** in ways that deliberately go beyond academic event formats. We are looking for innovative formats that combine sociology with artistic practice – whether through the explicit incorporation of sociological theories into productions, the participation of sociologists as commentators in the supporting program, or the development of plays that reinterpret social phenomena.

Sociology on Stage offers financial support for projects by arts and cultural institutions (theaters, museums, etc.) that bring sociological questions, analyses, and ways of thinking into dialogue with creative, aesthetic, performative, or cultural contexts, thereby making them accessible to a broader public.

A prerequisite for funding is a clearly recognizable sociological profile of the project: even in interdisciplinary or artistic formats, the sociological claim to knowledge and reflection must remain clear.

To apply, please send a brief description of the planned event – including how it aligns with the grant format (target audience, focus) – along with a rough cost estimate in a single PDF document (maximum 2 pages total) via email to the following address: info@kohlifoundation.eu.

Applications may be submitted on an ongoing basis and will be considered until the annual budget has been exhausted.
